To qualify as an Associate/Student Member, a person must be:

- (1) A full-time student in a program in hospital and health care administration or another discipline related to the purpose of WHCE, or
- (2) Currently unemployed and was eligible for Active Membership in his/her last employed position, or
- (3) Employed in the health care field in a position which does not qualify for Active Membership.

Who qualifies for membership?

Any person who is dedicated to a career as an executive in health services, holds at least a bachelor's degree, and meets the qualifications for one of the three membership categories listed above is eligible to be a member of WHCE, subject to approval by the Executive Board
